

ADOPTION STATEMENT

IWERNE MINSTER VILLAGE DESIGN STATEMENT SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that North Dorset District Council adopted the Iwerne Minster Village Design Statement as a Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 30 September 2011.

The Iwerne Minster Village Design Statement will encourage high quality design and safeguard local character through the adoption of a number of design guidelines that will be a material consideration for any new development in the village.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
